316 Responses (All Parents/Guardian)

65 (57%)

70 (43%)

Upon review of the survey results, we will not be moving forward with increasing the minimum passing score/grade from a “65” to a “70” for the 2017-2018 school year; however, we will conduct this survey again next year.

I hope to see increased support in raising the minimum passing score/grade to a “70” as a way to elevate the bar for our students.
