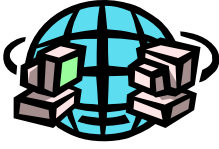


**North Arlington Elementary Schools  
Computer/Internet Acceptable Use Policy  
2008-2009 School Year**

The North Arlington School District provides the use of computer facilities and Internet access for educational use only. In order for the students to use the Internet, parents must give their permission. Please review these guidelines with your child and indicate your permission for your child to use the Internet.

1. Use the computer and Internet only with your teacher's permission and for the purpose your teacher has requested.
2. Your school computer files are not private and your teacher or system manager may see them at any time.
3. Do not attach devices such as cell phones, MP3 players, iPods, or flash drives to any computer.
4. Respect copyright laws: Do not copy materials without permission. Be sure to tell where you found your information.
5. Do not give your password to anyone.
6. Do not enter information about yourself.
7. Do not agree to meet anyone.
8. Ask your teacher about any messages that you receive that are not appropriate and make you feel uncomfortable.
9. Do not attempt to access profane or obscene material. If you do so accidentally, notify your teacher right away.
10. Do not enter inappropriate or hurtful language into the computer.
11. Students will be disciplined according to the general disciplinary practices if they do not follow these guidelines or if they utilize the computers and Internet inappropriately.

### Study Island

Several grade levels in the District are using an Internet-based program called Study Island. The Study Island programs are designed specifically to help students master the content specified in New Jersey's Core Curriculum Content Standards. Study Island's focus on the Content Standards enables students to improve their performance in all skill areas tested on the NJASK and HSPA, which leads to improved test scores. Study Island IS an Internet-based program, but students are monitored while using the program.

### Teleconferencing

The North Arlington School District is involved in a number of innovative technology programs, including the use of teleconferencing equipment. This equipment allows students and teachers to communicate with students and teachers in other schools in our district and in schools in other districts and other countries. Students may also take virtual tours of museums and other places of interest!

Your child will have an opportunity to participate in one or more of these telecommunications programs throughout the year. We need your permission to allow your child to do so.

### Student Photographs

There may be occasions when students' photographs may appear in various venues such as the local newspapers or district newsletters to highlight special achievements, etc. Please select the venues in which you would approve having your child's picture appear.

### Student Art Work or Writing

It is the policy of the North Arlington School District that a student's artwork or writing may be published on a web page developed for educational purposes with parental permission. Such published work will be identified by student's initials only.

A copy of all such student publishing prepared for the Internet will be printed out and brought home for the parent/guardian to see.

The work will appear with a copyright notice prohibiting the copying of such work without written permission of the parent/guardian. In the event anyone requests permission, that request will be forwarded to the parent/guardian for permission.

**Parental/Guardian Consent Form**

We are sending you this parental consent form to both inform you and to request permission for your child's photo/image and personally identifiable information to be published on the district and/or school's web site.

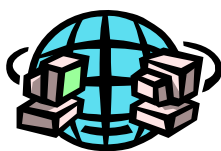
As you are aware, there are potential dangers associated with the posting of personally identifiable information on a web site since global access to the Internet does not allow us to control who may access such information. These dangers have always existed; however, we as schools do want to celebrate your child and his/her work. The law requires that we ask for your permission to use information about your child.

Pursuant to law, we will not release any personally identifiable information without prior written consent from you as parent or guardian. Personally identifiable information includes student names, photo or image, residential addresses, e-mail address, phone numbers and locations and times of class trips.

If you, as the parent or guardian, wish to rescind this agreement, you may do so at any time in writing by sending a letter to the principal of your child's school and such rescission will take effect upon receipt by the school.
